

05 honda civic anti theft system power button

After attempting to hold the ignition power down for 2 seconds a few times, I finally pressed the volume button down and everything rebooted into a screen telling me the system lost power and is acquiring its location from GPS satellites.

When I started my car this morning I got an error saying Anti theft was disabled due to power loss to the car. The car started fine and I did not remove the battery before/ever. ...

Fix 1 - Reset the system. Fortunately, in most cases, you do not need to reset the stereo code or enter a code. Instead, follow these steps: Turn the vehicle ignition to the "ON" position. Press the power button on the audio system to turn it on. Press and hold the preset buttons 1 and 6 simultaneously until the word "Code" appears on your display.

To reset your Honda's anti-theft system, you need to disable your Honda anti-theft system and follow this method. Here are the steps we need to take. Take your key and insert it into your driver's side door lock. Allow 45 seconds for the vehicle to sit before starting the engine by turning the key to unlock the driver's side door.

The message has the instruction to hold down the volumn button for 2 secs. to re-enable the audio system due to a power loss. While this message occurs any time power is lost, there's a bug in the system and it occurs randomly even when there is no power loss. The message also has a caveat that says if it happens frequently see your dealer.

This light's activation indicates the anti-theft system has detected a potential unauthorized use scenario. Observing this light is pivotal as it verifies the operation of the anti-theft system. Furthermore, the persistence of the light could denote that the vehicle doesn't recognize the key fob or that there has been an attempted break-in.
