Chicago is now one of the largest cities in the country to set a goal of 100 percent renewable energy. Building on the city"s pledge to run all municipal buildings on renewable energy by 2025, Mayor Rahm Emanuel announced a longer-term plan that will push Chicago to supply 100 percent of its energy from green sources by 2035.

There is a growing push for cities and businesses across the country to strive to use 100 percent renewable energy. The U.S. Conference of Mayors in 2017 approved a resolution supporting a 100 percent renewable energy goal by 2035. Businesses such as Coca-Cola, BMW Group, Bank of America, and others have committed to being 100 percent renewable.
