No luck. Either there's some issue with the volume button or something's just wrecked. For now, I'll just stick to fastboot continue whenever to restart, and back up everything using twrp (just in case) which I can run by flashing it as boot and fastboot continue and then doing the same with the original boot image when I'm done with twrp. - Kartikeya Chauhan

This method requires prior setup of USB debugging, so it's only effective if the feature was enabled before the power button malfunctioned.

If you always end up in fastboot mode the power is not the only one broken. Seems like your volume buttons are also broken so that the phone recognizes them as permanently pressed (or at least the volume down button). You can try running "fastboot continue" while connected to a PC. You must log in to answer this question.

3.1 Exit Fastboot Mode in Xiaomi/Redmi with Power Button. You can easily exit Fastboot mode using the Power buttons, as this method will conventionally turn on the device. Press and hold the Power key for 10-15secs till your MIUI device reboots. It will restart the phone system automatically.

Here"s how to get out of Fastboot mode with Minimal ADB and Fastboot Tool; Step 1: First, download and install " Minimal ADB and Fastboot Tool" on your computer. Step 2: After the installation of the program is complete, visit the installation directory. {ADB Installation Location: My Computer> C Drive> program Files> ADB Folder}

If you are a lucky user and you have a phone where you can remove the battery, you can do that to come out of Fastboot mode on your phone. When your phone is stuck in Fastboot mode or faces Android phone frozen issues, remove the back cover of your device and pull the battery out. This will power down your device.

My redmi note 7"s power button is broken, and it ran out of battery so it is powered off. I"d like to reboot it so I tried to use adb but it doesn"t detect the device when using adb devices (the phone is recognized by my computer and adb is set up right), I"m wondering if adb can detect devices that are powered off. Also, maybe I can try to simulate the power button with some tools but I ...

There are variations on how to enter Safe Mode -- the most important for an unbootable device is from a powered off state. Simply hold power, volume up, and volume down until the Android boot screen displays. After the boot symbol displays, release the power button, but continue holding the volume buttons until the operating system fully loads.

A damaged power button seems to be the end of the line for your device. But don't worry; there are plenty of alternatives to keep your device in a working state even when your Android phone's ...

If you want to put the Android phone into Fastboot mode, you can turn off the phone firstly. Then press and hold the volume down button & power button to enter Fastboot mode. But the key combination can vary in different Android models. How can I exit Fastboot mode normally?

To begin with, press and hold the Power key on your device for around 8-10 seconds. This will perform a force reboot of your device and it may then automatically boot to the OS. However, if you are still stuck in Fastboot, then head over to the next fix. Fix 2: Use Fastboot Menu to Boot to OS

Fastboot Commands to Flash System Image File and TWRP fastboot flash. This command is used to flash factory images, recovery, boot, radio, system, and other images to your Android device. Check out these examples: fastboot flash boot boot.img; fastboot flash system system.img; fastboot flash recovery recovery.img; fastboot flash cache cache.img

1. Run Odin on Android. You can press and hold the Volume down, Power, and Home button together on your Samsung. When you see a blue prompt on your screen, release the buttons and press the Volume up. Odin mode will be on. If you are using a phone with the Bixby key, press and hold the Volume down, Power, and Bixby together.

If you don't want to install ADB and Fastboot, you can use the commands in the Chrome browser via Web ADB irrespective of OS.



There are lots of ways to exit Fastboot mode but if you are looking for the 1 click exit to Fastboot mode then you have to use Reiboot for Android, developed by Tenorshare. It is a professional program that comes with some serious features and fixing stuck Android devices on Fastboot mode is one of them.

Connect the a USB cable to your phone and keep on pressing the volume down button while the phone is booting. If you are able to access the fastboot mode then you are saved and you can try fastboot reboot command. If your phone is not entering into fastboot mode then go to a nearby shop and get the power button fixed.

So the power button on my phone (Asus Zenfone 3 laser) no longer works and the phone is powered off. I have charged it up and gotten it to the android recovery menu by holding down power and simultaneously plugging it into my laptop. Unfortunately, I don't think USB debugging is turned on as adb devices and fastboot devices comes up empty.
