For example, you may run into a "Google keeps stopping" pop-up menu when searching for weather details, browsing the web, updating applications, or playing games on your Android phone.

This will open the System Configuration window. Go to the Services Tab. Check Hide all Microsoft Services and click on Disable All. Click on Apply. Restart your PC and check if PowerShell pops up. If the PowerShell still pops up, you can jump to the next solution. However, if the pop-up stops, you need to determine the service that is causing it.

My laptop keeps displaying a pop up that states "the power connector is not plugged in properly. Please disconnect and reconnect the power adapter". This wouldn't be as much of a problem if it didn't kick me out of certain games when it pop ups. I'm wondering if anyone else has experienced this problem or has a fix for it.

Push and hold the Power button until it opens the list of reboot options. Then tap on and hold the Power off icon for a couple of seconds. A new message will pop asking to boot in Safe Mode. Confirm it and boot up your smartphone to affect the above steps in Safe Mode.

solutions like clearing the Google app's data and cache, uninstalling any new updates, or rebooting your Android phone. This will make sure it isn't due to a bug or temporary glitch. However, if nothing works, follow the guide below.

Android notifications are great, but they're not perfect. The way that some notifications pop up on the screen can be annoying, especially if they're not important. Thankfully, you can stop this from happening. The bad news is that there's no way to turn off pop-up notifications all at once. You'll have to do it individually by app.

Use the System File Checker tool: The System File Checker (SFC) tool is a built-in utility that can scan your
