While NEM 2.0 mandated that all excess energy be credited at the full retail rate, which is the best-case scenario for solar customers and leads to the greatest long-term savings, with credits also rolling over to future months indefinitely, NEM 3.0 is much more conservative- and reduced the buy back rate for solar energy from retail rate to 75 ...

The good news is that installing solar panels can still be a money-saving move in California. California has a strong presence in the solar energy market, having ranked first in the nation for solar energy production in 2024 so far.

NEM 2.0 replaced 1.0 in 2017, offering slightly less than the retail rate for excess solar energy and requiring customers to switch to time-of-use energy plans. This policy has also been phased out as of 2023, and only customers who went solar under this program may continue receiving these credits.
