

You may only mail lithium batteries: Meeting the conditions outlined in Schedule 2, Special Provision 34 of the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations. Subject to the restrictions set out in the table below ; Please note: You aren't allowed to ship lithium batteries to any destination outside of Canada and the U.S.

Shipping Lithium Batteries. Open or Close content below Live Animals. Except in limited circumstances, pets and warm-blooded animals may not go in the mail. Shipments of live animals, including poultry, reptiles, and bees, have very specific packaging requirements.

How to ship lithium batteries in equipment. These type of batteries are built into equipment like laptops, smartphones and portable medical devices. They're classified as dangerous because lithium can catch fire if overheated or damaged. That's why there are regulations in place to ensure they're packed correctly.

Effective July 1, 2015, all existing customers and new customers who wish to ship lithium metal batteries without equipment (UN3090) via UPS ® Air services must obtain pre-approval from UPS Airlines. This requirement is to ensure that proper training has occurred and that all applicable safety regulations are properly followed for such shipments.

Lithium batteries are used in many electronic devices such as cameras, cell phones, laptop computers, medical equipment and power tools. Most consumer-level electronics usually use small batteries to keep these devices compact and portable, so there should be no issues with regards to shipping them. Packages containing lithium batteries require the appropriate Caution Label. Consult your shipping carrier for any specific regulations when shipping electronic devices with batteries.

Lithium batteries are dangerous goods, and all of the regulatory requirements must be complied with, as set out in the Lithium Battery Shipping Regulations. In the United States, failure to comply with these regulations can result in a civil penalty of up to \$27,000 per offence (LBSR 1.3).
