Almost all rechargeable devices, from cell phones to power tools, contain lithium batteries and may require that you declare the package contains hazardous materials when shipping your item. When shipping with USPS, these items can only be sent via Ground Advantage.

The lithium batteries must be of a type that have successfully passed the UN38.3 tests and contain the necessary systems to prevent overcharge and over discharge between the batteries.

lithium batteries. Never send recalled lithium batteries by air; doing so can be very dangerous and may result in fines or penalties against you, the sender. In addition, UPS does not transport recycled batteries by air. UPS air services that have the potential to travel by air include:

For shipping lithium batteries with USPS overseas, you can ship a maximum of 4 cells or 2 batteries that are installed in the new or certified refurbished equipment or device it operates, without any lithium battery markings. However, individual batteries are prohibited from USPS international shipping.

For shipping, all types of lithium batteries are classified as dangerous goods -- with special regulations for packing, labelling, documentation and handling. FedEx adheres to IATA regulations for shipping lithium



batteries by air and ADR regulations for shipping lithium batteries by road in Europe.

There are regulations attached to the cross-border shipping of batteries to ensure they travel safely. These regulations vary depending on the type of batteries. Lithium batteries, for example, are classified as Dangerous Goods, so not all types of lithium batteries are accepted by DHL Express which you can check here.
