

Check system power error please plug in ac adapter

I decided to write this post only now after a new outcome after a crash, that lead me into the ASUS BIOS utility in advanced mode, with a message from EZ flash "Check System Power Error: Please plug in AC Adapter). Is the power supply the issue or is software related?

So connect your laptop to the mains adapter, then press any key to continue. Upvote 0 Downvote. R. Rune g. Jun 19, 2019 4 0 10. Jun 19, 2019 ... Check System Error! PLEASE PLUG AC POWER THEN PRESS ANY KEY TO FLASH BIOS 0% (I think I had a lock on the right top corner as well). Upvote 0 Downvote. T. TomXD. Jul 20, 2019 1 0 10. Jul 20, 2019

So I was trying to upgrade the SSD. I am in the pud recovery part but after a prolonged checking I get a message with the topic title. I hit next and get Battery Detected! Detaching Adapter and then gets stuck in a loop. If i unplug it the whole system powers off. Any advice?

Resolve the "Check system power error" with a hard reset, discharging residual power causing the misread. This process resets hardware and clears temporary configurations. Turn off ASUS ROG Ally, disconnect AC adapter. If removable, take out the battery. Hold power button for 60 seconds to discharge power. Re-insert battery, connect AC adapter.

I plug the adapter into the laptop and remove the battery to save it for the next time I need to start the laptop. And once the adapter is plugged in it says Not charging,so it still has a problem, so I need ...

Disconnect the power cable from the AC adapter. Connect the power cable firmly to the AC adapter. Verify if the LED on the AC adapter is on. If the LED is not turning on, try a compatible, known-good AC adapter. After reseating the power cable and AC adapter cable, if the laptop is not able to turn on with the AC adapter, go to the next step.
