Their burning releases carbon dioxide, a major greenhouse gas that"s accelerating climate change. Nuclear energy is a second type of non-renewable energy that makes up only 2% of global energy, but 8% in the U.S.

Biomass energy relies on biomass feedstocks--plants that are processed and burned to create electricity. Biomass feedstocks can include crops, such as corn or soy, as well as wood.
