



# Dimensions of solar panels

Refer to the solar panel size chart below for a comparison of average residential and commercial solar panel dimensions. The average U.S. residential utility customer uses 893 kWh per month. To completely offset this usage, the average American would need a 6.7 kW solar panel system. Most solar panels have an output rating between 250 W and 400 W.

**Commercial Panel Dimensions.** Commercial solar panels have larger dimensions than their residential counterparts. For example, a residential solar panel system can measure 65 by 39 inches and have 72 cells. A commercial solar panel can measure 78 by 39 inches and have 96 cells overall. They can also weigh around 50 lbs. or higher.

The only other limits you'll encounter to the size of the solar panels system you'll get are limits maintained by utilities on the largest size of solar system eligible to be interconnected to their grid (20 kW for Dominion in Virginia, for example) and limits on system sizing relative to how much of the customer's energy is going to be ...
