

Do i need an apple manufactured power cord to backup

If you use Apple's iCloud backup, your phone will automatically back up every time your phone is locked, connected to power, and connected to a Wi-Fi network. If you use a Mac, your iPhone will back up every time you connect your phone to a port on your Mac (either USB or Thunderbolt, depending on how new a machine we're talking about).

However if you're not pulling a lot of power, it's not really a consideration. If you were running a kilowatt through a cord that long it might be. Generally you should use a cord only long enough to get where you need to go. If it's a permanent installation, I would re-terminate the cord at the plug-in point to eliminate unrequired length.
