Seneca Falls Hydroelectric Project. Located in historic Seneca Falls, NY, birthplace of the women's rights movement, the Seneca Falls hydro station takes advantage of excess water flow and elevation created by the construction of the Cayuga-Seneca Falls Canal in the early 1900s.

Gravity currently has more than 40 MW of hydroelectric projects operating and under development across the country. In New York, Gravity owns the Chittenden Falls, Stillwater and Mill Pond hydro facilities, in addition to Seneca Falls and Waterloo.
