

You reset the Honda Odyssey anti-theft mechanism by pressing and holding the panic button on the key fob for five seconds. But what if that fails? How can you fix or silence an anti-theft ...

Customer: I have a 2001 Honda Odyssey V6 and anti-theft is engaged. Vehicle will start and run but will not shift and all lights on dash and radio are blinking including red anti-theft light. ... This may reset the anti-theft system and allow you to start the engine normally. Make sure the anti-theft light on your dash is no longer blinking ...

He"s getting new batteries for the key fob and looking into the anti-theft system because the green key light blinks after the van dies. After reading other threads in the forum, I think the anti-theft immobilizer is a possibility, but it doesn"t make sense that the van starts up and runs briefly sometimes and not others.

In a few words: The immobilizer or anti-theft system verifies that the key used to turn the engine on is the correct one. If the key is not the correct one, this system blocks different actions to prevent the car from starting. When this system is activated on your Odyssey a warning light such as the one below will turn on:

Many Honda models will have the radio code listed on a small white sticker inside the glovebox. The five or six digit code will be labeled "Anti-Theft Radio Code." Enter this code through the preset radio buttons on your radio. You will hear a beep ...

Try a different key. Better yet, use the spare Honda Odyssey key if you have one. 4). The Door Lock Cylinder Is Damaged. If the anti-theft system only misbehaves when you insert the key into the door lock, the door lock cylinder is damaged. The anti-theft system keeps responding because it doesn't recognize the key.

If you value the infotainment system a lot don't get the 2018 odyssey. I have a 2018 and it has been constant various issues. Front screen goes black. Tuner not working. Dvd won't play. My rear screen cable is now worn



out so only displays if wire is in just right spot. Front screen is black when using remote start. Backup camera doesn"t display.

I tried rebooting with a Logitech K400 I have. It does reboot, but does nothing to fix the Rear screen/CabinWatch issues. Basically once the issue starts happening (I.e. rear display goes off, front screen says "Network connection lost") if ...

The current, fifth generation of Odyssey has been on sale since 2013. It was retired early in 2022 as Honda Australia cleared out remaining stock following the closure of the Sayama, Japan plant where it was built. "The reality is, we were disappointed that the Odyssey was discontinued globally.



There are several ways to reset the anti theft system in a Honda Odyssey, depending on model year. You can try removing the fuse in the engine compartment fuse box on the driver's side fender. Take it out for about a minute then reinsert it. If that didn't work You try disconnecting the negative battery terminal for a little bit and reconnecting it, this will reset the ...

I replaced the battery in my 2011 Honda Odyssey and now the anti-theft code will not reset the radio. I"ve confirmed the radio code via the Honda website AND via Honda telephone support. I"ve described the "behavior" of the radio, below. Please help!!! The confirmed radio codes do not work to reset the radio, but...
