



How much to solar a house

Solar panel costs vary from state to state, partly due to the area's average electricity bill and solar suitability. For example, Hawaii pays the most for electricity, while Utah pays the least. Those in Hawaii stand to see bigger savings than those in Utah when going solar.

The average pre-incentive cost of home solar is \$29,161 for a three-bedroom house, or \$20,412 after claiming the 30% tax credit. However, as shown in the chart below, the number of bedrooms isn't a great indicator of the size and cost of a solar system - and neither is living space, for that matter.

What solar installers really need is a recent energy bill and a sense of the complexity of the project." How much do solar panels cost for a 1,500 square foot house? According to 2022 averages, solar panels cost around \$27,500 before incentives, and around \$19,250 after the 30% tax credit for a 1,500 square foot house.

Solar panel systems on homes are typically up to 4kWp. A system of this size can generate more than 3,000kWh per year. For comparison, a home using a "medium" amount of electricity gets through 2,700kWh a year on average, according to energy regulator Ofgem.

A solar energy system will likely increase a home's value. A DOE-funded study at the Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory found that solar panels are viewed as upgrades, just like a renovated kitchen or a finished basement, and home buyers across the country have been willing to pay a premium of about \$15,000 for a home with an average-sized solar array.

The average pre-incentive cost of a solar system for a 3,000 square foot home was \$30,100 based on thousands of sales conducted on solar in 2022. The number of panels in these systems depends on the price point from the installer and power rating of each panel. The table below shows a few common scenarios for a 3,000 square foot home.

How much is a solar system for a 2500 sq ft house? The national average cost of a solar system for a 2,500 square foot house is just over \$20,500 after the 30% federal solar tax credit is applied. The average pre-incentive cost - or contract price - is \$29,374.

Solar panel installation costs a national average of \$16,500 for a 6kW solar panel system for a 1,500 square ft. home. The price per watt for solar panels can range from \$2.50 to \$3.50, and largely depends on the home's geographical area. Residential solar panels are usually sized at 3kW to 8kW and can cost anywhere from \$9,255 and \$28,000 in total installation costs.
