



How to draw a solar system

Make images of the planets in this order from the sun: Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune. Sketch rings between the planets to indicate their orbital paths. Draw the Sun near the left side of the page. The sun is the largest body in the solar system, so draw a large circle to represent it.

There are so many ways you could make the drawing match the majesty of our solar system. For example, we will focus on the stars in the background. This is a detail we can see from our planet, as we can behold millions of twinkling stars in the sky.

3. Choose where your model solar system will go. 4. Calculate scale distances. 5. Calculate scale planet sizes. 6. Calculate combined scale distance and planet size. 7. Create and display your model. 8. Make a Solar System on a String (scale distance model) 9. Solar System on the Sidewalk (scale distance and/or size model) 10.

Use the scaled-down distances to draw the solar system to scale. Start by drawing the Sun on a piece of paper. Then, measure and mark the scaled-down distances from the sun for each planet using a ruler. When you're finished, draw the planets over the marks you made.

Calculate the scale factor when the actual measurements of the solar system and the model are given. Every planet in the solar system orbits around the sun. To show this in your drawing, draw a curved path coming off of the top and bottom of each planet. Extend the paths toward the Sun and off the edge of the page to show that each planet travels around the sun. Make sure none of the orbital paths you draw intersect with each other.
