When making Saturn and Uranus, wait for the circle shape of the planet to dry before using the ring mask to add the rings. Glue the planet label on when you're finished. 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Earth and the other planets in the inner solar system are relatively close together, compared with the planets that lie beyond the asteroid belt in the outer solar system. While it may seem like Neptune is far from our Sun, on this scale, the nearest star to our Solar System Proxima Centauri would be about 7 kilometres away.

The solar system is like a giant family portrait of our cosmic neighborhood. It's made up of our Sun, the star at the center, and all the celestial objects that orbit around it. ... 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Have students write the planets average temperature in marker on the toilet paper under each planet. Have students answer the questions on the worksheet to make connection about the sun's role in temperature throughout the solar system and in the temperature of planets.
