



Lithium battery disposal hawaii

Per UPS guidelines, air shipments must also include the following statement: "Lithium ion battery - PI 965, Section II". Properly packaged and labeled lithium battery shipments comply with national and airline regulations, ensuring safe transit to destinations like Hawaii.

Various lithium ion battery disposal regulations apply when a battery reaches its end of life. At this point, the battery is considered waste and hazardous waste regulations also apply.

When you know how to dispose of batteries, you can help the environment. Dropoff sites typically accept rechargeable batteries for recycling. For single-use batteries, you can get a mail-order recycling kit. Putting alkaline batteries in the trash is allowed in many places. However, recycling these batteries when possible is the best choice.

All lithium batteries must have both terminals covered by non-conductive electrical tape to avoid short-circuit in the collection box. Sand for waste disposal can be found at the battery collection area and in the Chem Van. On the LMG, the alkaline battery collection point is in the Electronics Lab. This container is for alkaline batteries only.
