Publications Publication 52 Revision: New Mailing Standards for Lithium Batteries . Effective March 2, 2015, the Postal Service(TM) will revise Publication 52, Hazardous, Restricted, and Perishable Mail, in various sections to provide new standards for the mailing of lithium batteries.. These revisions were initially announced via a notice in the Federal Register on January 26, ...

The warning labels shown in Exhibit 325.3 a, Exhibit 325.3 b, and Exhibit 325.4 may appear only on mailpieces containing mailable hazardous materials that require use of the label under Postal Service requirements. Division 5.1, 5.2, Class 8 and Class 9 labels are only permitted when used in conjunction with a Limited Quantity air mark. Exhibit ...

#1:Yes, you can ship lithium batteries via USPS. However ... There are currently six types of lithium batteries eligible for shipment, in varying domestic or international quantities, via USPS: Don't forget the new lithium battery marks that became mandatory this year!

Mailers may optionally use a DOT-approved lithium battery handling label, in domestic air or surface transportation. Quantities must be within the limits of 349.22. n For mailpieces ...

The Postal Service has issued new requirements for shipping used electronics and other hazardous materials. Effective June 6, mailers must separate all material requiring hazardous markings or labels into identifiable containers. ... tablets -- that either contain or are packed with lithium batteries must be mailed by surface transportation ...

The Postal Service announced these revisions via a Federal Register notice titled "Revision to Mailing Standards for Lithium Batteries," which was published on July 26, 2017 (82 FR 34712-34715).

I just sold an item on Posh, they sent me a different USPS label and I had to print out a lithium ion "ground only" label to put on the box. So far, so good. I haven"t shipped an item on my own (outside of Posh), yet.

In November of 2022, the United States Postal Service (USPS) proposed new rules to amend Publication 52, Hazardous, Restricted, and Perishable Mail (Pub 52) open_in_new that require shippers to identify shipments of hazardous materials (HAZMAT). Compliance with these rules is required by July 9th, 2023. A refresher on ...

Be VERY careful with lithium batteries. Lithium-ion batteries are considered highly flammable and can overheat in high temperatures, so they usually require a special UN 3481 label on the package, as pictured above.. If shipping via the United States Postal Service, for example, packages containing lithium-ion batteries must have a DOT-approved lithium battery mark on ...

A lithium battery shipping label serves this purpose and warns handlers to pack, store, and ship the packages that contain lithium batteries properly and according to regulations. The US DOT sets a piece of comprehensive information on shipping lithium batteries and the penalties accompanied by non-compliance



with these regulations.

It is a legal requirement to label packages containing lithium batteries with the appropriate UN 3481 label when they are being transported by air, sea, or road, to ensure the safe handling and transportation of the hazardous material. 3481 Lithium Ion Battery Labels. 3481 Lithium ion battery labels are made in America at LabelValue.

The Postal Service clarifies that labels commonly used with other transportation providers are not permitted on mailpieces containing lithium batteries installed in equipment, when these mailpieces are intended for international mail.

Except for mailpieces containing button cell batteries installed in equipment (including circuit boards), or no more than 4 lithium-ion cells or 2 lithium-ion batteries installed in the equipment they operate, mailpieces containing lithium-ion batteries must bear a DOT-approved lithium battery mark, as specified in 49 CFR 173.185(c)(3)(i) and ...

How to Use Pub 52. USPS Publication 52, commonly known as "Pub 52", is a public document that contains the hazardous materials shipping regulations, restrictions and guidance for both you and Postal Service employees to ensure the safe and successful transport of lithium batteries and other hazardous material.

- For Domestic Shipments: - The United States Postal Service (USPS) does not provide specific labels for lithium batteries for domestic shipments. - However, USPS requires that packages containing lithium batteries adhere to specific packaging requirements and be marked with the appropriate Class 9 Label, indicating the presence of hazardous materials.

If your laptop has a lithium battery, you have to use a special label that indicates that your package contains lithium batteries. You can get this label from a postal store or online. The label should have the words "Lithium Battery" and "UN 3481" on it, ...

Lithium metal batteries will use labels with one of the following UN numbers: UN3090 UN3091; If you're shipping lithium metal batteries as a standalone (no other items in the package), use a battery label with UN3090. If you're shipping lithium metal batteries contained in or packed with equipment, use a battery label with UN3091.

Warning Labels and Markings ... FOR LIMITED QUANTITY MAILINGS. Must be used in conjunction with a Limited Quantity air mark (except dry ice), the proper shipping name, and identification number.

Each lithium metal cell and battery must contain no more than 0.3 gram of lithium content. Each lithium-ion cell/battery must have a watt-hour rating of not more than 2.7 Wh.
