Solar Power is the third studio album by New Zealand singer-songwriter Lorde. It was released on 20 August 2021, by Universal Music Group, inspired by the death of her retriever cross dog Pearl and her visit to Antarctica in 2019. The album was written with producer Jack Antonoff to capture solipsism and summer escapism, mainly focused on Lorde's leisure time in her homeland New Zealand, ...

Lorde's prioritization of private pleasure over the duties of pop stardom helps explain the parts of Solar Power that don't wow: a clutch of ballads written with such memoirist precision, and ...

When Lorde made her comeback "Solar Power" (the lead single from her third studio album of the same name), Billboard described it as "a fresh chapter in a riveting book, and Lorde fans should be thrilled to meet this new author". Both the debut single and the recently-released "Mood Ring" provide listeners a glimpse into what the full "Solar Power" universe ...
