Once again, this only unlocks after you reach Level 20 and travel to a new cluster, upon which Admiral Hackett will give you the Assignment.

Most of the nebula's material was pulled toward the center to form our Sun, which accounts for 99.8% of our solar system's mass. Much of the remaining material formed the planets and other objects that now orbit the Sun. (The rest of the ...

Fuel is expended in Mass Effect 3 every time you pilot the Normandy into the void between star systems. Mass Effect jumps do not expend fuel, nor does travel within a system. If you run out of fuel you will be automatically returned to the nearest system with a Mass Relay.

Earth is a Planet in Mass Effect. Earth is located in the Sol system within the Local Cluster.Planets can be explored while you traverse the galaxy, sometimes you can land on them and other times you only can survey them from the Normandy to obtain resources.

The Rogue VI will be on the Earth's moon, so you''ll need to travel to the Sol system in the Local Cluster. You can find this location on the south part of the galaxy map. The Earth's moon ...

Check out the following pages: As with the Local Cluster itself, the Sol system doesn't unlock until you attain Level 20 and travel to a new cluster, upon which you're given the UNC: Rogue VI Assignment by Admiral Hackett at the Galaxy Map. Sadly, there's no Discoveries to be made in the Sol system.

It appears you are a little bit mistaken - while there were Prothean Ruins (and technology) on Mars, the only Mass Relay in the System was orbiting Pluto; The so-called "Charon Relay" was discovered in 2149, only a year after the Prothean Ruins were discovered on Mars.Given the level of advancement of humanity before the Prothean Ruins were uncovered, it was not ...

The Sol system. Sol is the home system to the humans and the Systems Alliance. Note that Pluto appears on the system chart and is considered a planet for game purposes, as Pluto had not yet been reclassified as a "dwarf planet" when Mass Effect was released. Charon is not on the star map, but is included here for background.

You"ll get access to the Solar System (in the Local Cluster) when you first open the galaxy map after reaching Level 20 (or probably 10 with the Legendary leveling mode?) and receive the Rogue VI assignment. ...
