Personally, I use a compressed co2 tank (power tank) which enables use of air tools, and I can use it on my welder.

Similarly to Milwaukee, Craftsman is a name recognized the world over. It has long made premium tools, and with the V20 makes a great portable tire inflator for use just about anywhere.

There are two types of Air Chucks that are used on most hoses used in the auto industry. There is the Industrial which is the more common and there is the Automotive which is the less common. My Monaco has a Automotive chuck for my air connection in my bay, but I have an Industrial for the air chuck (same on all my air tools).

Portable tire inflators are generally manufactured with two design types in mind: handheld devices and console units. Here are the differences between the two: Handheld is the way to go for a tire inflator to keep in your car in case of emergencies. A handheld inflator should be easily stashable and simple to use.

C7 Z06 Discussion - Portable Tire Inflator - Anybody have a good experience with an easy to carry electric inflator that will work with ZO6 sized tires. Fuel station air is getting hard to find. The one I had got hot and blew out the hose after about a 2 psi increase.

Always double-check your psi with a handheld tire pressure gauge before and after using any tire inflator. 12-volt DC car power cords that plug into your "cigarette lighter" outlet require the engine to be running to power the device. Threaded screw-on connectors will provide a surer seal but can be hard to manipulate in cold weather.

I air up each tire in about 60-75 seconds each, using an onboard CO2 tank, but a 10# fill only lasts me airing up 4-5 times so as a backup I have the aforementioned Smittybilt 5.65 cfm. It does that same job in about 2 minutes.
