This cost doesn't factor in any state or utility rebates and incentives for going solar.

The upfront price for an average-sized residential solar system has fallen from \$40,000 in 2010 to about \$25,000 today. Meanwhile, utility-scale solar now costs between \$16/MWh and \$35/MWh, making it
