



Removing solar panels from roof

3 February 2022 at 4:44PM. Any advice?....my solar panels, fitted ten years ago have unfortunately damaged my roof. The repair bill is estimated to be £7000. The company I used has ceased trading, my insurance company tells me I'm not insured for shoddy workmanship, relevant trade associations say any warranty has expired....even trading ...

I love the idea of solar power but the aesthetics of my roof are more important to me. Only a guess, but if you have 16 panels, then it's probably a 4kWp system generating around 3,000-4,000kWh pa, and earning FiTs + export of around £600-£800 pa till 2033.

If you remove the solar panels you must let us know using the "Contact us" banner above and as a minimum, send us a combination of the following: 1. Written confirmation from the installer/decommissioning certificate. 2. Photographs of the site and dismantled equipment. 3.

Who owns my Solar Panel Lease? hightower1 Posts: 5 Forumite. 4 August 2020 at 12:47PM. I've only just found out the Rent-a-Roof scheme lease holders for the Solar Panels on my Roof went in to liquidation a few years ago. The company was called Idea Home Group PLC based in Ringwood.

If your position & posts are genuine, you really do need to think about doing some research before removing the panels if it is an early generation installation with a high FiT rate, maybe a "half-way" option would be to look at replacing the panels with a newer all black panel array of the same capacity, but you would need to check the ...
