

The blinking light on a Ryobi battery indicates various status messages. A slow blinking light means the battery is charging, while a fast blinking light signals a problem such as overheating or voltage issues. To troubleshoot, refer to the user manual for specific blinking patterns and their corresponding meanings.

That sounds- Yes, it sounds like a dead battery. Or one that's basically in a deep sleep. For most Ryobi batteries that have been deeply discharged, you can place them on the charger and wait. Once the normal voltage is reached within the battery, it should shift into a normal charging mode.

If you get a flashing GREEN light and a solid RED, the other battery is defective and should be recycled. If, however, you get the flashing GREEN and flashing RED light with a different battery, the charger is probably defective. At this point, you probably need to take the charger in to get looked at by a professional or replace it altogether.

Which yes your charger is saying there is a problem with the battery. Never try to revive a dead battery by jumping the main terminals with another 18volt, 40 volt sourcebattery. Yes it may work, but you also risk overcharging one of the cells which can lead to a cell going into thermal run away, and then you have a lithium fire on your hands.

Customer: I have a Ryobi battery charger OP408VNM that flashes red and green on my Ryobi 40v lithium battery 6ah for my Ryobi walk behind lawn mower. I left it in overnight and still flashed red and green. I also have a compatible battery (not Ryobi) with the same specifications as the original one that is only a few months old.

If all LEDs are flashing or if the first and last LED are flashing, this could indicate that the battery has overheated. Allow your battery to cool before attempting to charge or use it in a tool. (Cooling could take between 15-20 minutes, depending on the battery or ambient temperature). If the inner two LEDs are flashing, the battery may have engaged the overcurrent protection.

One common reason for the red and green blinking is an overheated battery. Ryobi battery chargers have built-in safety mechanisms to prevent damage to the battery due to overheating. When the charger detects excessive heat, it stops the charging process, resulting in the red and green blinking lights. This protects the battery from potential harm.

If the red light is flashing it means defective battery. I'm not sure what charger you have but all of them I've ever had comes with a placard on top of the charger the shows solid green is charged. Flashing green is charging. Solid red is plugged in and ready. Flashing red is get ready to drop a bill on new batteries.

A solid RED light should always be on when there isn"t a battery present. If you don"t have a solid RED light when you plug in the charger, you need to keep in mind that not all Ryobi chargers include an ORANGE LED. However, they should all have RED and GREEN ones. 2.
