Solution 2: Check the Cable. Make sure that the cable is properly connected and is not damaged. If possible, try using a different cable to see if the Seagate external hard disk light not blinking not detected is resolved.

One potential reason your Seagate external hard drive may be running but has no light is damage to the external enclosure. The enclosure houses the actual hard drive and contains the light that indicates power and activity. If the enclosure is damaged in some way, it can prevent the light from turning on even if power is going to the drive.

Flashing rapidly usually means data is being transferred to/from the drive. Slow Blinking - A slow, blinking light usually means the drive is idle or in standby mode, awaiting instructions from the computer. Flashing in a Pattern - Some Seagate drives blink in a specific repeating pattern to indicate an error code and self-diagnostic result.
