For the older variants of the Alarm system, if the beeping does not stop after disarming the Alarm, then you should take out the batteries from the alarm and then put them back inside. Turn on the Alarm to check if the problem persists.

It takes 24 to 48 hours for your alarm system battery to recharge after power has been restored. The low battery message should clear once the battery is recharged. If you are still experiencing battery issues after waiting for your battery to recharge and silencing the low battery beep, your battery may need to be replaced.

Press the OFF key to silence low-battery warning beep at the keypad. Note: The low battery message will still be displayed to remind you about the weak battery and that it is up for replacement within 30 days. Replace the battery. The low battery display will clear only when you have installed a new battery.

AC power failure - If your alarm/keypad is beeping because of a power outage, you can silence it by pressing Command 4 on your command button. Press Clear if you have a Clear button. You can enter your digital code if you don"t have a command or clear button (make sure this doesn"t arm your system).

On my system, the alarm starts a high-rate beeping every time the power comes back on after an outage (not when the power goes off).
