Solar Power is the third studio album by New Zealand singer-songwriter Lorde, released on August 20, 2021. Seven singles were released - Solar Power, Stoned at the Nail Salon and Mood Ring, Fallen Fruit, Secrets From a Girl (Who's Seen It All), The Path & Oceanic Feeling. In late 2017, Lorde said she wishes to produce and write an album by herself with no ...

Solar Power:9/10 To hear solar power for the first time is equivalent to trying to stare at an eclipse without glasses:it will make you look away at the risk of going blind. That seems to have been the general consensus. Lorde's return came with a bright warning as SP bright lead single invited us to join her on her idyllic commune.

The result is Solar Power, a weird, meandering album that is an exercise solely in fulfilling her own desires. Speaking to the New York Times last year, Lorde dismissed any idea that the album could be a smash, saying that she felt like she "could just chill out and flex a little bit."

Solar Power opens with "The Path," which sees Lorde turning away from a life that's been thrust on her: "Teen millionaire having nightmares from the camera flash / now I'm alone on a windswept island." She seems to smile as she nods to her absence: "Won't take the call if it's the label or the radio.

I go to Lorde for angst so while I can appreciate solar power for what it is for her, it's not the type of music I personally care to listen to. There is that ~30 second moment in fallen fruit where I'm like "yes this is it" then it goes back to ukuleles and meh... just not my taste.

The Solar Power Tour was the third concert tour by New Zealand singer-songwriter Lorde, in support of her third studio album Solar Power (2021). The tour took place from April 2022 to March 2023, spanning over 70 shows in North America, Europe, Latin America and Oceania. The show consisted of three segments and an encore, with two or three costume changes.

Solar Power might well be seen as just that: an album to kick back with on a summer's day. But there is, as Lorde puts it, "deep and shallow" to this record. There are meditations on celebrity culture ("California") and the wellness industry ("Mood Ring"), alongside sorrow for the destruction of the natural world.

Solar Power partly emanates from Lorde having resigned from social media during her absence from the pop world--an intentionally off-the-grid, out-of-touch perspective that, as wise as it might ...
