

Solar Power (Pokémon Ability) Effect. Increases Special Attack to 1.5× but costs 1/8 max HP after each turn during strong sunlight. In-Depth Effect. During strong sunlight, this Pokémon has 1.5× its Special Attack but takes 1/8 of its maximum HP in damage after each turn.

The easiest way to get use out of solar power is having another pokemon with an ability that sets the weather you want, like torkoal, then swapping to charizard. Blaze is simpler, though you'll rarely get any use out of it, as actually being within the very small window of activation is rare. If you don't want to think too hard, blaze will be ...

Effect. Solar Blade charges up sunlight on the first turn and then unleashes the power as an attack on the second. Solar Blade will not need a turn to charge if used during harsh sunlight will have its power halved if used during rain, hail, or sandstorm.. If a Pokémon holding a Power Herb uses Solar Blade, it will consume the Power Herb to execute Solar Blade in one ...

Effect In battle. Orichalcum Pulse summons harsh sunlight in battle as soon as a Pokémon with Orichalcum Pulse enters the battle. Its effects are the same as the move Sunny Day, which lasts for five turns. This can be extended to eight turns if the Pokémon is holding a Heat Rock.. Orichalcum Pulse also boosts the Pokémon's Attack stat by roughly 33% (or more ...

Pokémon with the ability Leaf Guard cannot be afflicted by major status conditions. The Special Attack of Pokémon with the ability Solar Power increases by 50%. Heliolisk is the first Pokémon to have more than five hangul characters in its Korean name. Heliolisk and its pre-evolved form are the only Pokémon to have three possible Abilities (Dry Skin, Sand Veil, and Solar Power) that are affected by three different weather conditions (rain, sandstorm, and harsh sunlight, respectively).

It will last for five turns if created using Drought (Generation VI onwards), Orichalcum Pulse, or Sunny Day, or eight if created by a Pok  mon holding a Heat Rock.

Solar Power (Japanese: ?????, Hepburn: Sun Power) is an Ability introduced in Generation IV. Nine Pok  mon have this Ability, one is a Mega Pok  mon. Boosts Sp. Atk, but lowers HP in sunshine. In sunshine, Sp. Atk is boosted but HP decreases. Boosts the Sp. Atk stat in sunny weather, but HP decreases.

Strong winds have no effect on Solar Beam's power. Solar Beam can also be used as part of a Contest Spectacular combination, with the user gaining an extra three appeal points if Sunny Day was used in the prior turn. Generation VII.
