



# Solar power rebates arizona

Solar photovoltaic installation: A \$0.05 per-watt rebate, up to a maximum of \$2,500. Solar water heating: A \$0.75 per-kilowatt-hour rebate of estimated first-year energy savings.

If you live in Arizona, you are eligible for both a statewide solar tax credit and the federal solar tax credit that will save you thousands of dollars on a new solar installation.

If you live in AZ, you'll get a credit worth 25% of your solar panel system cost, up to \$1,000, towards your AZ state income tax bill. The system can be installed on either your ...

The federal solar investment tax credit (ITC) is the most significant solar incentive in Arizona. You may also take advantage of tax breaks, rebate programs or incentives through Mohave...

Arizona doesn't have as many solar incentives as it used to, mostly because utilities have started meeting their renewable portfolio standard goals. But Arizona still has a handful of statewide solar incentives available to homeowners, and a couple of utilities and electric co-ops have solar and energy storage rebates as well.

Arizona offers Net Billing, which allows solar owners to make money from excess solar energy. Most Arizona homeowners are eligible for residential solar tax credits. We've highlighted the key tax credits and rebates available in Arizona below. Most solar owners in Arizona qualify for their utility company's net-billing program.

If you live in AZ, you'll get a credit worth 25% of your solar panel system cost, up to \$1,000, towards your AZ state income tax bill. The system can be installed on either your primary or secondary residence, but you can only claim \$1,000 per year.
