

A. There is, and it's a little counterintuitive: If you disconnect the battery, the Fios "battery backup unit" should stop nagging you about replacing it. That's "should" but not "will," because the answer depends on the age of the Fios hardware in question, Verizon spokesman Harry Mitchell explained.

Verizon is replacing the bulky lead battery BBU with new power reserves when they come out to fix or install ONT"s. i believe the new one that was installed uses the D cell batteries which you can now just replace at a lower cost.

Definitely don"t switch to the power supply. The BBU is 12 VDC to the ONT. The power supply is 48 VDC. If you connect that directly to the ONT you might fry the ONT. You also need the signal wiring which the power supply does not provide.

The Verizon installer (a very helpful guy) came back today to install an older backup unit (DUPS-1232V) that uses a real backup battery, but surprise; it apparently isn"t compatible with the I-211M-L ONT I have. For some reason, it periodically does something to the power which resets the ONT, interrupting the Internet connection.

These backup power sources provide power only for your Verizon voice service, including Emergency 911 dialing, depending upon your specific device. How do I stop my battery from beeping? Note: The reboot will temporarily disrupt all your fios services and take between 3 to 5 minutes to complete. How do I dispose of my old battery?

I am pleased with Fios (though the Verizon customer support website could use some help), but charging you 50 bucks to replace the battery is something not even the cable company would do. note also: the back-up battery powers only your phone service in the event of a power outage (according to tech support; no internet, no tv).

You cannot easily replace the power supply / battery unit ("BBU"). The ONT communicates with it to obtain status on power and battery. It's more than just supplying the correct voltage. You have several options to deal with the low battery: Remove the current battery and press the battery silence button.

The MoCA/Ethernet and Video services remain active for <10 minutes once the mains power is disconnected, at which point the ONT disables them, based on a signal from the BBU which tells the ONT that it is on battery backup power. (BTW, this behavior can be hacked, and internet/video can be made to remain connected even when on battery power.



Just to clarify. I had the BBU originally with the 12v battery. That was the one that was replaced but it was not replaced with the same thing. It was replaced with a smaller black box thats about half the size so there is no way that there is any batteries in that box Plus I already proved it by disconnecting it and the phone not working so there is no battery inside this small ...

" This is the power backup unit provided by Verizon with FiOS service. The user manual describes the Auxiliary DC input connector as " 1.3 mm" but that's only half of the specification.

The Verizon backup power option available for your Fios service depends upon the Verizon equipment installed in your home. If your ONT (Optical Network Terminal - usually found in your basement or garage) is installed with a power adapter that looks like the image below, then you"ve come to the right place to order a Fios Voice Backup Battery as your backup power option.

The old "Battery Backup Units," or BBUs, were discontinued years ago. Verizon actively removes them from service when they work on customer systems. The BBUs only provide a few minutes of backup for internet service, and several hours for phone service. If you don't have fios phone service, they aren't very useful.

Maintaining Your Fios Backup Battery. If you have a Verizon Fios backup battery, it is important to maintain it properly to ensure that it functions correctly during a power outage. Let's look at some tips for maintaining your Fios backup battery, including testing the battery, the battery replacement procedure, and troubleshooting common issues.

Recently had Verizon install a new power supply (replacing the old battery backup version) and now EVERY time I lose power, I have to go to my garage ... Fios Internet and High Speed; Power Supply Issues; ... The battery backup or power reserve simply keeps your Verizon phone working for 8 hours or more during a power outrage.

A cable runs from this cable out to the FIOS battery back up unit which is mounted inside my crawl space. This battery back up is plugged into an electrical outlet that is inside my crawl space. I also have another cable leaving my ONT that is mounted to the side of my house.

First off, there at least two main types of BBUs. There are several that use lead-acid rechargeable batteries (with the AC/DC charger included) and are a quite a few different battery backup units as you can see here. Some models of ONTs use a PowerReserve unit that uses D-cells rather than a rechargeable 12V lead-acid battery, which apparently keeps the ...

When everything is working properly the power supply powers up the ONT. If you loose power the BBU kick in and the 12V lead acid battery will power the ONT for up to 8 hours. ... Battery-backup model number: Cyber Power DBH36D12V. I have a 1,300 volt-amp UPS. It has 5 battery-backup outlets & 5 surge-only outlets. ... Follow Verizon Fios ...



That's odd. The typical BBU (battery backup unit) supplies all power to the ONT. It signals the ONT when running on battery which causes the ONT to switch off TV and Internet. The system is designed to never run TV and Internet from battery. The battery will only last a few hours, so we know you weren't using it.

If the customer has a land line and still wants a battery backup there"s a new model. It"s a tray that holds 12 D cell batteries and connects to a standard power supply. I"ve been replacing them for many years and the option to bill for a BBU/power supply replacement doesn"t even exist on our closeout screen.

Ensure connectivity to the Verizon Fios network by making sure your ONT power supply unit stays plugged in at all times. Your ONT requires electricity to operate all Verizon Fios services: ONT plugs directly to an existing electrical outlet at your location; An indicator light lets you know if electrical power is present

As stated the Verizon Supplied battery is for phone service only. I have had the Verizon power supply and router plugged into an ...

First, you must unplug the battery backup unit from the wall outlet. Always do this before working with the unit. Then open the door to the battery unit and locate the small plug to the left of the battery itself. You will see a red and black cable leading from the battery to a plug component.

I know the battery backup unit is designed to keep the phone service during a power outage, but is there any way I can access internet during a ...
