Method 2. Create a System Image using WBADMIN command. The next method to create a system image backup, in Windows 10, 8 or 7, is by using the &quot;WBADMIN&quot; command, which enables you to back up and restore your operating system, volumes, files, folders, and applications from a command prompt.

Create a system image for your full Windows 10 backup. You'll find the "Create a system image" option under the "Control Panel Home" heading. Click it and confirm your administrator ...

Open the Windows 10 Settings with the "Win + I" key shortcut.; After opening the Settings, go to "Update & Security". Select "Backup" on the left panel. Click on the "Go to backup and restore" link on the right panel. Now, click on the "Create system image backup" link. You can find it on the left pane of the control panel.

If your Windows environment ever becomes unstable or corrupted, setting up a system image backup could fix the issue--if you take the time to prepare in advance. This backup method creates an entire image file of Windows 10 or Windows 11, which can then be safely stored elsewhere.

Windows 10 has multiple built-in backup systems to help you back up the entire system or individual files. For example, to backup files in a specific drive, you can use the File History feature.

A system image includes the operating system and all your system settings, programs, and files found on the C: drive. You can use it to restore the content on your computer if your hard disk or solid ...

If you want to use an external drive, make sure it's formatted using NTFS in order to store the image. Click Next. Confirm which areas or partitions of your hard drive will be included in the image file, then click the Start Backup button. Windows now creates the image file and saves it to your chosen destination.

Step 3. Select bootable media: CD/DVD or USB drive is recommended, because it's convenient. Also, you can use ISO File option, and you still need to burn it to CD/DVD or USB if you want to boot computer from it. Confirm and click Next to start the process. Except for Create Bootable Media, you can still create a recovery environment in Windows 10 if you don't want to ...

If you want to create a DVD ISO file, you can click on the "New" button on toolbar or choose the "File > New > Data CD / DVD Image" menu, then select "UDF DVD". You can also change the media type by clicking the media type area in the right bottom of the window.

Way 2. Using Backup and Restore (Windows 7) Backup and Restore is a built-in Windows backup app to help you create a hard disk image. Here is how: Click the Start menu and input Backup in the search bar. Select Backup and Restore (Windows 7). Tap Create a system image. Select the PC's hard drive you wish to create an image of.
